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**Notification**

1. As per the provisions of section (4) of “Karnataka Compulsory Service Training by Candidates Completed Medical Courses Act, 2012 (Karnataka Act 26 of 2015) (As amended by Act 35 of 2017)”, and as per Karnataka Compulsory Service Training by Candidates Completed Medical Courses (Counselling, Allotment and Certification) Rules, 2015”, all candidates who got admitted during the academic year 2019-20 under Government quota or Private quota (including management and NRI quota) and have successfully completed post graduate diploma or degree, shall undergo one year compulsory service in Government hospitals in urban area, selected and posted on the basis of merit through process of counselling in Karnataka State.
2. Online counselling will be conducted for posting candidates on merit basis as mandated in Rule 5 of “Karnataka Compulsory Service Training by Candidates Completed Medical Courses (Counselling, Allotment and Certification) Rules, 2015”.
3. The following points pertaining to counselling are to be noted:
  - i) Every candidate (Government, Private, Management or NRI quota irrespective of Universities) who have joined post graduate diploma or degree during 2019-20 batch and who have not done one year compulsory service in Karnataka State will have to choose the Government Hospital in urban areas where they would wish to undergo compulsory service, based on vacancies shown through online counselling.
  - ii) Based on their options and according to their merit they will be posted to various Government Hospitals in urban areas where vacancies are available as notified.
  - iii) Non-entry of the options by the candidate will amount to non-compliance of the order and extension of time will not be considered. The candidate will be posted suo-moto as per vacancy available as on date by the competent authority.
  - iv) The candidates will be paid stipend as per section 4 of the 2012 Act.
4. Following are the steps which will be followed for purpose of posting for one-year compulsory service in Government hospitals /Institution on the basis of merit.
  - i. The link for option / priority entry for selecting available vacancy will be shared on the Health and Family Welfare website <https://karunadu.karnataka.gov.in/hfw>.
  - ii. The online counselling shall be merit based.
  - iii. As per Rule (5) of the said Rules, the merit list of candidates prepared and sent by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS) for post graduate diploma and

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degree is published and considered for allotment based on the priority as entered by the candidate.

iv. Candidates have to register for counselling mandatorily.

5. Process of online options entry and allotment:

- i. The candidate may select his/her subject/post graduate diploma or degree and Government Hospital as per available vacancy options at the time of entry of option.
- ii. Post graduate diploma/degree stream wise vacancies have been shown in Government Hospitals located in urban areas in the State where basic facilities are available to treat patients.
- iii. The order of priority selected can be re arranged or deleted by the candidate, until the last date for option entry.
- iv. Candidates are advised to enter any number of options to avoid any disappointment of being posted Suo-moto (from the existing vacancies) by Competent Authority.
- v. After the compilation of all the priorities and based on the merit list, the candidate's posting order will be confirmed and there after notified.
- vi. Once allotment process is complete and notified, there is no scope for seeking any change of allotment.
- vii. The allotment logic/module/system follows the Merit of the candidate along with the entered options and priorities given by the candidate. An illustration of the same is attached as Annexure-1 to this Notification.

6. While doing the counselling based on the merit, priority shall be given in following cases, namely,-

- a) Candidate or his spouse or children are suffering from serious and terminal ailments for which medical treatments are not available at his place of posting;
- b) Physically challenged candidates with more than 40% of disability as certified by District Medical Board/having Unique Disability ID;
- c) Cases of Widow's;
- d) Cases of Husband and wife who are Government servant (Have to produce certificate in the prescribed format as annexed and
- e) General cases.

**Candidates are advised to upload the related documents on the portal if the above mentioned categories are applicable to them.**

7. No accommodation will be provided by the Government/DME/College. However, the Colleges or related District Surgeon/Administrative Medical Officer may consider their request, subject to availability of accommodation.

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
