NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for the vacant post of **Director at Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health, Bangalore.**

Minimum Academic Qualification:-

1. Should possess the recognized postgraduate medical qualification i.e., M.D. in Paediatrics, M.Ch., in Paediatric Surgery or equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Medical Council of India.
2. Should have minimum of ten years teaching experience as Professor / Associate Professor / Reader in a Medical College / Institution recognized by the Medical Council of India (of which not less than five years shall be as Professor) respectively in any of the following department:
 - i) Paediatrics
 - ii) Paediatric Surgery
 - iii) Medical Genetics
 - iv) Clinical Haematology
 - v) Endocrinology
 - vi) Immunology
 - vii) Medical Gastroenterology
 - viii) Medical Oncology
 - ix) Neonatology
 - x) Nephrology
 - xi) Neurology
 - xii) Cardiology

Note: In the case of the departments mentioned at Sl. No. (iii) to (xii) above, the candidates should have acquired two years special training in the concerned subjects in an institution recognized by the Medical Council of India.

Teaching Experience:-

1. Candidates for the said post shall be selected based on seniority cum merit from amongst the teachers in the same autonomous institution.
2. 5 Senior most willing Professor as per the cadre wise seniority list of professors shall be considered by the Governing Council for the said appointment.
3. Candidates shall have administrative experience either as Medical Superintendent or as Head of the Department or as Professor at least for 05 years.
4. Candidates shall satisfy Medical Council of India norms for appointment to the said post.
5. Maximum upper age limit for the said post shall be 02 year earlier to superannuation.
6. Candidate's probationary period must have been declared.

Mode of Selection: The eligible candidate shall be selected by a selection committee comprising of the following members

Note: The Governing Council shall nominate two experts in the concerned subject who have no vested interest in respect of the eligible candidate shortlisted prior to the selection.

Pay Scale: 37,400 – 67,000 + AGP 10,000/- (Pre-Revised A.I.C.T.E Pay Scale)

Period of appointment:- Maximum 3 years or till the date of superannuation, whichever is earlier.

Age Limit:- The applicant's age should be neither less than 50 years nor 58 years of age as on the last date fixed for submission of application.


