MARINE FISHERIES

- Construction, renovation and maintenance of fishing harbours and fish landing centers
- NABARD assisted RIDF projects for construction of fisheries link roads, bridges, jetties & Markets
- Assistance for motorization of traditional fishing crafts
- Transfer of Subsidy amount equivalent to state sales tax directly to the bank accounts for the diesel supplied to mechanized fishing boats
- Assistance for construction of fish markets
- Strengthening of fish marketing in Northern Karnataka under RKVY through KFDC & Private Participation
- Renovation and Maintenance of fisheries link roads in coastal districts
- Subsidy on power consumed by ice plants in coastal districts

Inland Fisheries

- Disposal of fishery rights of tanks, reservoirs & river stretches
- Development of Reservoirs through stocking of advanced fingerlings
- Fish seed production, rearing and distribution
- Subsidy on Purchase of Fish Seed
- Distribution of Fishery requisite kits
- Free supply of fish seed for stocking in small ponds and open wells
- Facility of free water and soil testing at taluk
