The five Electricity Supply Companies (ESCOMs) in the State of Karnataka have filed petitions in **O P Nos. 29, 30, 31, 32, 35 /2015** seeking permission of the Commission to implement the Domestic Efficient Lighting Programme (DELP). Under the programme, ESCOMs have proposed to offer to the consumers the option of purchasing LED lights at a cost lower than the market rate and recover from the consumers, the cost of the lights under Upfront payment scheme or On bill Financing scheme, as mentioned in the petitions.
