

# KARNATAKA ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION BANGALORE

**Notification No.Y/01/4 dated 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2007**

**Fourth Amendment to KERC (Recovery of Expenditure for Supply of Electricity) Regulations, 2004.**

## **Preamble:**

Whereas, Section 46 of the Electricity Act, 2003 empowers the State Commission to authorize by way of regulations, a Distribution Licensee to charge from a person requiring a supply of electricity in pursuance of Section 43, any expenses reasonably incurred in providing any electrical line or plant used for the purpose of giving that supply, the Commission by virtue of the said powers, read with Section 181 of the Act has notified " KERC (Recovery of Expenditure for Supply of Electricity) Regulations, 2004" in the Notification no.Y/01/4 dated 12-11-2004 and the same was published in Part-3 of Gazette of Karnataka dated 16-12-2004 (Page nos.2216 to 2222). In order to minimize electrical accidents occurring in the ESCOMs, certain suggestions have been brought to the notice of the Commission. Therefore, after examining the matter, the Commission deemed it appropriate to bring in certain amendment to sub-clause no.3.2.1. Hence, this Fourth Amendment is notified.

## **AMENDMENT**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 181 read with section 46 and sub-section (2) of section 43 of the Electricity Act 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all powers enabling it in that behalf, the Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following Regulations further to amend KERC (Recovery of Expenditure for Supply of Electricity) Regulations, 2004.

### **I. Title and commencement:**

- a) These Regulations may be called the KERC (Recovery of Expenditure for Supply of Electricity) (**Fourth Amendment**) Regulations, 2004.
- b) These Regulations shall come into force from the date of publication in the official Gazette of Karnataka.
- c) These Regulations shall extend to the whole of the state of Karnataka.

### **II. Amendments to the following Regulations of KERC (Recovery of Expenditure for Supply of Electricity) Regulations, 2004:**

The existing sub-clause as in column 3 of the Table below shall stand substituted by the provisions as in column 4:
